The Windsor C-1 School District will have a summer school program for the high school level. The classes are available for any student from Jefferson County going into grades 9-12 (completed the 8th grade).

Deadline for signing up is Friday, May 26th.

June 5 – June 30

Morning classes: 8:00am – 11:00am

Lunch: 11:00am – 11:30am

Afternoon: 11:30am – 2:30pm

**Students that are enrolled in both sessions will not be allowed to leave campus at any time during the day without permission from an administrator and parent.*

ATTENDANCE

Regular attendance for the summer school program is mandatory. Students must be present every day. **If a student misses any part of any day they will NOT receive any credit towards graduation or promotion and will be dropped from the program.** In addition, students must be on time. Tardies will not be allowed and may be cause for dismissal from the summer school program.

LUNCH

Students will have the opportunity to purchase a lunch for \$2.40. If a student was considered free/reduced during the end of the 2016-2017 school year, this will carry over to summer school.

** No outside food is allowed during lunch unless approved by an administrator.*

TRANSPORTATION

Transportation will be provided for Windsor C-1 students if they attend both sessions. If a student is only attending one session, transportation is the responsibility of the student/parent.

DISCIPLINE AND DRESS CODE

Disruptions to the classroom and school environment will not be tolerated. Any acts of this nature will result in immediate dismissal from the summer school program.

Clothing must be appropriate for school. Normal school dress code will be strictly enforced. If a student wears any inappropriate clothing to school they will be sent home for the day and lose their credit. Students must be covered from the shoulders to the mid-thigh. Articles of clothing, which display sexually suggestive wording or symbols, profanity and/or other obscenities, tobacco, alcohol, or other drug symbols or advertisements, will not be permitted. No hats or head coverings.
