Dear Parents:

In follow-up to my correspondence from earlier today, I would like you to be aware that with all potential threats, there is the “copycat” element that usually arises from such. In anticipation and preparation for such potential occurrences, we have spoken with the Jefferson County Sheriff’s Department about having an increased presence on campus and they have assured us that they will work cooperatively with us in this effort.

These types of situations can create an opportunity for students to place threatening types of information on social media, graffiti on school property, text messages, phone calls, notes, etc. that can be utilized to keep a situation like this afloat. Often times, these instances are not specific or targeted at anyone in particular; however, if this does occur, we will take each one seriously and be in contact with law enforcement officials. Please take the opportunity to stress the importance of sensitivity to these types of situations with your child, and the potential ramifications that can occur, even when one may have no ill intent. Threats in any form made against our students, even those intended as a joke, will absolutely not be tolerated and all such threats will be pursued by the District to the fullest extent in accordance with the law and District policy.

If you or your student has any information related to potential threats against the District, please contact the District or your building level administrators immediately. We appreciate your cooperation and patience and understand that this places a high level of stress and frustration on you as a parent. We have a wonderful environment at Windsor, with so many positive things happening by and for our children. I assure you that I, along with the Board of Education, the administration, and our teachers and staff, will diligently and continuously work to protect our children so that they can learn and thrive in safety and peace of mind, which is what they most definitely deserve. Thank you.
