Dear Parents,

Today, our High School Administration discovered that someone had made a graffiti written threat in one of the boy's restrooms. The Jefferson County Sheriff's Department was contacted immediately.

Various students were interviewed that had entered the restroom prior, and currently, there are no viable suspects. The safety and welfare of each child is paramount to our District and any and all threats, credible or not, will be taken as such.

The District will have additional police presence on campus next week. If a student or students are found to be guilty, they will be subject to a 180 day out of school suspension and a potential recommendation for expulsion, as well as potential legal repercussions. These instances, credible or not, hold extremely punitive consequences.

If the District receives additional information regarding the threat, we will notify you immediately. Thank you.
